

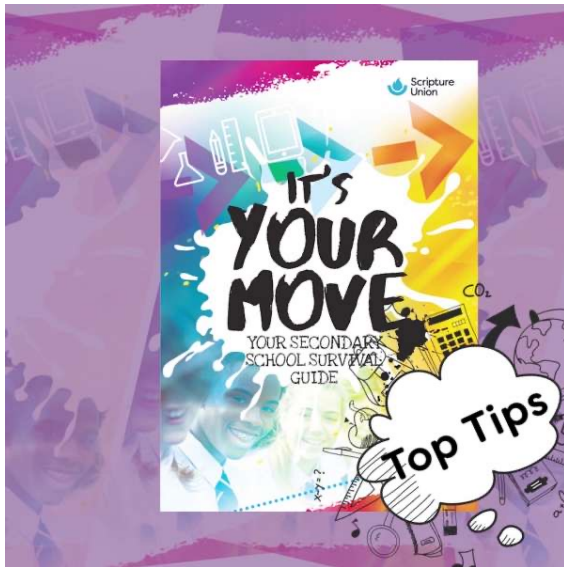

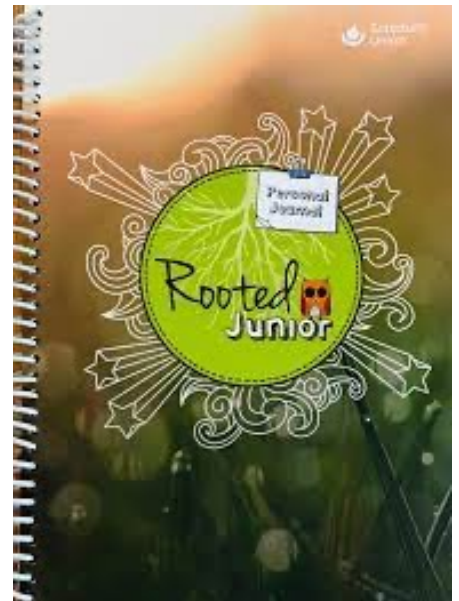

After half term we will be doing our Y6 transition workshop using the Scripture Union resource, 'It's Your Move'. This 90-minute workshop will encourage students to think positively about Secondary School and give them opportunity to ask and explore any questions or concerns they may have. We have created an action-packed workshop that includes a backpack race, a tie challenge, drama, quizzes, games, survival tips from Bear Grylls, and opportunity to share the Bible and testimony about the Christian faith. We currently have 37 workshops booked across 24 Primary Schools. Please pray for us as we deliver our IYM workshops.
